SUGAR MARKET NEWSLETTER

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I: BACKGROUND

The Kenya Sugar Board produces a monthly market newsletter that gives insights into the performance of the sugar industry in a given period. Attention is focused on local sugar production, wholesale and retail prices, imports, exports, sugar by-products and the global sugar market outlook. This **September 2025** newsletter gives a comparative analysis of the sugar industry performance in the period January - September 2025 and 2024.

II: INTRODUCTION

a) SUGAR

Total sugarcane milled in September 2025 declined by 18 percent, falling from 465,981 MT in August to 382,467 MT. The drop was recorded in most of the operational sugar mills, except in Muhoroni Sugar Company (2025) and South Nyanza Sugar Company. During the review period, KISCOL, Naitiri, Busia, Butali, Chemelil and Nzoia remained closed.

A total of 4,967,512 metric tonnes (MT) of sugarcane was milled between January and September 2025, representing a 30 percent decline from the 7,100,428 MT recorded during the same period in 2024. This significant drop is attributed to a reduced supply of mature cane available for crushing.


Sugar made dropped by 17 % to 33,853 MT from 41,031 MT in recorded in August 2025. The industry average tonnes of cane to tonnes of sugar (TC/TS) ratio improved slightly from 11.36 in August to 11.30 in September 2025.

Total sugar production (bagged) in September decreased by 17 % to 33,845 MT from 40,800 MT in August 2025. Cumulative sugar production from January to September 2025 totaled 440,652 MT, down 28 percent from the 615,499 MT produced in the same period last year.

Sugar sales by millers dropped by 7% in September 2025, reaching 38,139 MT, down from 41,014 MT in August 2025.

The review period ended with sugar closing stocks of 14,063 MT, down 24% from 18,395 MT in August 2025. More details on sugar production, sales and closing stocks are given on Figure I overleaf.

Figure I: Sugar Production, Sales and Closing Stocks (MT)




b) MOLASSES

In September 2025, molasses production decreased by 33% to 13,148 MT from 19,480 MT in August 2025. Cumulatively, molasses produced from January to September 2025 decreased by 34% to 189,809 MT from 286,877 MT in the same period last year.

Molasses sales increased by 5% to 17,061 MT from 16,184 MT in August 2025. The total closing stocks of molasses as at the end of September 2025 were 12,628 MT down 25% from 16,826 MT in August 2025.

The decline in milling activity over the last eight months has led to an increase in molasses prices. In September 2025, molasses prices ranged between Kshs. 26,000 and 33,096 per tonne, with a mean price of Kshs. 29,377 per tonne, up from Kshs. 23,925 per tonne in August 2025. More details on molasses prices are given in Figure II overleaf.

c) SUGARCANE PRICES

In September 2025, sugarcane prices remained at Kshs. 5,750 per tonne, in compliance with the minimum set price. The last revision was done by the Interim Sugarcane Pricing Committee on 21st July 2025.

III: LOCAL SUGAR MARKET


a) Ex-Factory Sugar Prices

The weighted ex-factory sugar price for September 2025 increased marginally by 0.05% to Kshs. 6,888 from Kshs. 6,885 per 50 kg bag in August.

Overall, the ex-factory prices during the month ranged between Kshs. 6,780 and Kshs. 7,000 per 50kg bag.

Figure III, overleaf illustrates the movement in ex-factory sugar prices in September 2025.

b) Wholesale Sugar Prices

During the month of September 2025, the wholesale sugar prices increased to an average of Kshs. 7,215 per 50 kg bag, up by 2% from Kshs. 7,080 per 50kg bag in August 2025.

During the review period, the prices for both local and imported sugar ranged between Kshs. 6,350 and 7,800 per 50kg bag. The average price for local sugar was Kshs. 7,222 per 50kg bag, while that for imported sugar was Kshs. 7,197 per 50kg bag. The market had a balanced presence of both locally produced and imported sugar, with each type being readily available across various outlets.

Wholesale stocking prices for local sugar ranged between Kshs. 6,800 and 7,400 per 50kg bag, with a mean price of Kshs 7,113. Imported sugar was stocked at prices between Kshs. 6,250 and 7,650 per 50 kg bag, with a mean of Kshs. 7,076 per bag. The overall average-stocking price for wholesale sugar was Kshs. 7,101 per 50kg bag. Wholesale prices for the

20kg bale of locally produced sugar ranged between Kshs. 3,100 and 3,550, with a mean price of Kshs. 3,292 per 20 kg bale, while the stocking prices ranged between Kshs. 3,000 and 3,400 with a mean of Kshs. 3,199 per 20kg bale. Imported 20kg bales were available in a few outlets, selling at an average price of Kshs. 3,222, with a stocking average price of Kshs. 3,120. 

c). Retail Sugar Prices

The average retail sugar price in September 2025 was Kshs. 171 per kilo down 3% from Kshs. 176/kg in July 2025.

Unbranded rebagged sugar, both local and imported ranged between Kshs. 145 and 200 per kilogram. The monthly average price for local unbranded, rebagged sugar was Kshs. 161/kg while that for imported sugar was Kshs 157/kg.

Sugar repackaged in generic brands such as *Nutrameal*, *Economy*, *Shivling*, *Quick choice*, *Naivas* and *Adoris*, both local and imported, ranged between Kshs. 155 - 225 per kilo, with an average of Kshs. 174/kg. Local repackaged sugar ranged between Kshs. 155 and 225 per kilo, with an average of Kshs. 174/kg, whereas imported sugar ranged between Kshs. 157-220 per kilo, with an average mean price of Kshs. 175 per kilo.

Local branded sugar was trading between Kshs. 145 and 225 per kilogram, with an average price of Kshs. 181/kg. Branded imported sugar averaged Kshs. 187 per kg with limited availability. Typically, branded sugar retails at a higher price than generic brands, and unbranded rebagged sugar.

Overall, the weighted average retail price of sugar (all types: unbranded, rebagged, repackaged, and branded) was Kshs. 171/kg.

During the review period, stocking prices for local sugar in retail outlets ranged between Kshs. 6,800 and 7,550, with a mean price of Kshs. 7,218 per 50kg bag. Imported sugar was stocked at a range of Kshs. 6,800 - 7,300 and the mean price of Kshs. 7,053 per 50kg bag. Overall, retail stocking prices for the month averaged Kshs. 7,152 per 50kg bag.

The retail stocking prices for local branded sugar ranged between Kshs. 2,950 and 4,000, with a mean price of Kshs. 3,383 per 20 kg bale.

IV: FOREIGN TRADE

a). Sugar Exports

In September 2025, total sugar exports were 28.575 MT, down from 55.99 MT in August. Kenya is a net sugar deficit country, and most of its production is consumed locally. For more details, refer to Table VII.

b). Molasses Exports/Import

In January - February 2025, molasses exports were 2,582 MT, destined for Tanzania, Uganda and Oman. The average FOB value for January and February 2025 were Ksh 11,531 per tonne and Ksh 10,737 per tonne respectively. In the period March - August 2025, Kenya did not export molasses.

From January to April 2025, Kenya did not import molasses. In September 2025, total molasses imported was 212.27 MT, all sourced from Uganda, at a CIF value of Kshs. 12,795 per tonne. Cumulatively, molasses imported between May and September, totaled 1,486.27 MT, sourced from Uganda and South Africa.

c). Sugar Imports

In September 2025, sugar imports totaled 41,582.25 MT, 35% down from 64,149 MT in August 2025. The imports comprised 29,397.25 MT of Mill White/Brown sugar and 12,185 MT of White Refined sugar. COMESA FTA countries supplied 12,060 MT, and COMESA non-FTA 4,750 MT.

From the EAC, 16,527.25 MT was imported, from Uganda and Tanzania. The remaining 8,245 MT was sourced from non-COMESA countries.

Mill White/Brown sugar was mainly imported from Uganda, Egypt and Eswatini, while White Refined Sugar was mainly sourced from Saudi Arabia and India. Saudi Arabia supplied 32% of the total White Refined sugar imports, while Uganda and Egypt accounted for 50% and 17% of the Mill White/Brown sugar imports respectively.

c) CIF Value

In September 2025, CIF Mombasa landed values for imported White Refined sugar averaged Kshs. 80,799 /MT compared to Kshs. 94,219 /MT for Mill White/Brown sugar. The overall average value for both White Refined and Mill White/Brown sugar in September 2025 was Kshs. 90,286 per MT, down from Kshs. 91,226/MT recorded in August 2025. In September 2025, Saudi Arabia was the leading exporter of White Refined Sugar to Kenya, accounting for 32% of the imports, at a CIF value of Kshs. 79,024 per tonne.

The CIF value of Mill White/Brown sugar imported from Tanzania averaged Kshs. 95,896 per tonne, while from Uganda averaged Kshs. 99,374 per tonne. Mill White/Brown sugar from Malawi was the cheapest, at a CIF value of Kshs. 77,674 /tonne.

V: WORLD SUGAR MARKET

a) The Market in September 2025

Global raw and white sugar prices fell to new lows in September. Fundamentally, the market continues to focus on ongoing CS Brazil production, where the sugar allocation for the season is likely to exceed 50% for the first time in decades.

This is supported by ethanol market dynamics, with more corn-based product coming to the market annually. At the same time, increased US corn ethanol supply is helping to meet global demand, reducing the need to divert domestic feedstocks, especially sugar, elsewhere.


The average ISA Daily Raw Sugar Price in September fell to USD16.05 cents/lb, from USD16.74 cents/lb in August, with the August average broadly in line with levels recorded over the two preceding months.

The ISO White Sugar Index average in September also declined to USD466.68/tonne down from USD475.30/tonne last month and the low of USD468.57/tonne in June.

The **Nominal White Sugar Premium** (the difference between the ISO White Sugar Index and the ISA Daily Price), averaged USD111.50/tonne in September, extending the recovery seen over the past months.

a) Conditions and Prospects

According to the International Sugar Organization's September report, the Current weather has been beneficial for cane development, although recent storms might result in a delayed start to this season's harvest.

Czarnikow, the London-based commodity trader and advisory company issued its latest update for the 2025/26 season. It projects a global surplus of 7.4 mln tonnes, up 1.2 mln tonnes from its previous report. Production is expected to reach 185.3 mln tonnes while consumption declines to 177.8 mln tonnes. The following season (2026/27) could have a surplus of 4.4 mln tonnes.

VI: WORLD MOLASSES MARKET

Prices

Molasses prices have started to diverge in the major trading hubs in recent months. In the EU, the price of cane molasses rose in July to EUR226.50/tonne up from EUR208.00/tonne seen in June. EU beet molasses prices in contrast eased to EUR136.10/tonne from EUR149.90/tonne in June. Molasses prices in the EU are likely to trend higher as local supplies are expected to fall significantly. For cane molasses, continuing trade impediments will see constrained availability to the world market, also suggesting prices will be supported going forward.

Exports

S&P Global estimate that supplies of molasses will remain tight this year and next, shrinking the Asian deficit. There are four sizeable exporters of molasses in the Asian Pacific region, of which two (Thailand and Vietnam) have also been active as importers in three of the last five seasons. Australia, Indonesia and Thailand will likely be the biggest exporters in 2025, followed by Vietnam. There is nothing to suggest that India's government will remove its export tax, meaning shipments in both 2025 and in 2026 are expected to be minimal. *Source:*










